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### Stoddard Celebrates the Retirement of Mrs. Linda J. Robinson, Executive Clinical Director, for 44 Years of Nursing Services.



Mrs. Linda J. Robinson, R.N., B.S.N., has retired after 44 years of acute care management and leadership in nursing services with 12 of those years at Stoddard. Beginning in 2005, she served as the Director of Nursing at Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home for five years and then as the Executive Clinical Director for over seven years.

Mrs. Robinson always shared with the nursing staff, "to always care and treat residents and family members the way you would like to be treated."

Mrs. Robinson has accomplished the following Milestones (to name a few) at Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home and Stoddard Baptist Global Care:

- ◆ Discontinued usage of Agency nursing staff and implemented an in-house PRN Nursing Pool for licensed nurses and CNAs.
- ◆ Implemented 24-hour staffing level census program in collaboration with the Finance Department.
- ◆ In collaboration with the Administrator and the Department Heads, worked toward achievement of 5-Star Rating for Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home.
- ◆ Implemented a modified Tracer Methodology Nursing Report Program for the Stand-Up Meeting to enhance resident-centered care.
- ◆ Assisted in facilitating four 5K Walk/Run Races to enhance exercise and mobility for the residents/staff, community involvement and to generate funds for Stoddard.
- ◆ Provided oversight/management for the Admission Departments at SBNH and SBGC.
- ◆ Served as the Compliance Officer in collaboration with the Executive Team, Human Resources Department and all Department Heads to ensure regulatory requirements and consistency in policies and procedures for all employees.
- ◆ Assisted in updating and writing over 70 policies and procedures for Nursing and other Departments.

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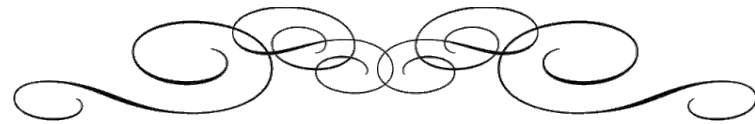


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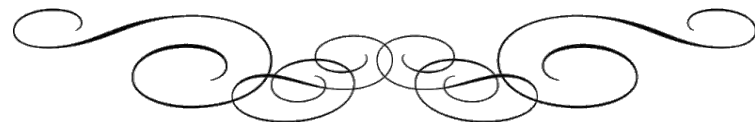
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**Rev. Walter Fauntroy Visits Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home**

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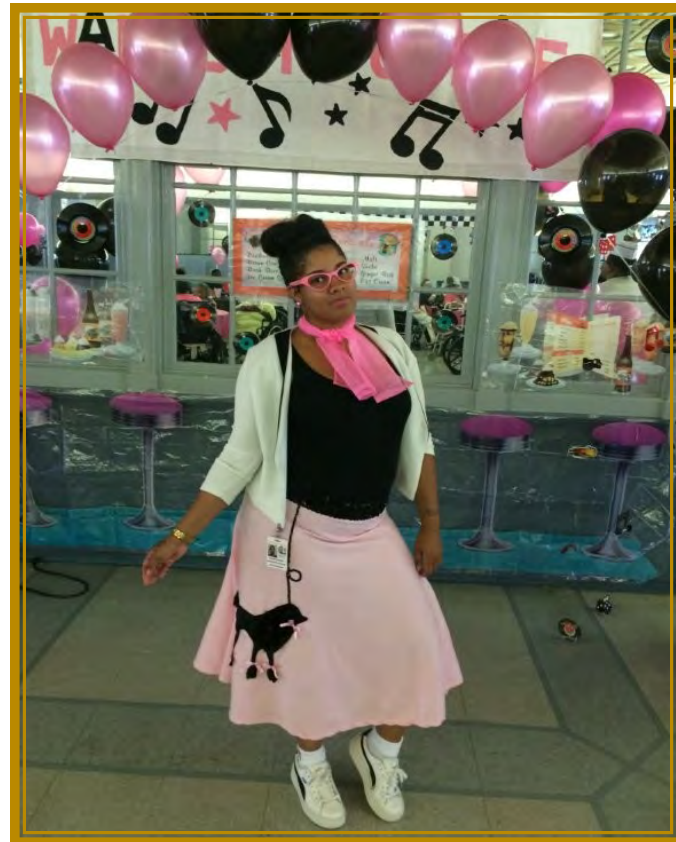
