



A Veteran of the Army, Mr. Young is very proud of the service he provided. He received his Basic Training in Fort Dix, New Jersey in 1983. Mr. Young's next stop was Aberdeen Proving Ground, a United States Army facility located adjacent to Aberdeen, Maryland where he received his Ordinance Training as a Tank Mechanic. 

- Minister Robert P. Campbell, New Jerusalem Baptist Church


